

Excerpt from BBC 1 TV Panorama broadcast Monday 15<sup>th</sup> April 2103

Reporter John Sweeney.

At 26 min 15 seconds into recording,

having found a major hospital cold and without any patients, Sweeney says:

We asked a doctor who defected about her experience of North Korean hospitals (back view of female doctor) if you as a doctor had said, “we need more money for medicines for the patients.” What would have happened to you?”

“If that happens they would kill me. The next day or even that same day they would kill you regardless of your ranking. Even a high ranking official would be killed. Everyone knows that.”
